INTRODUCTION

Following the success of last year's Little Devils Tour, Kirkby Lonsdale Motor Club will be running a repeat event on SUNDAY, September 17th, 2023. The format will be the same as last year, with a Tulip Roadbook, some manned passage checks and code boards to collect on the way round. REGULATIONS

1.0 EVENT DEFINITION

1.1 The *THE LITTLE DEVILS TOUR* organised by KIRKBY LONSDALE MOTOR CLUB, is a non-competitive "Touring Assembly" for all road going cars of any age. All vehicles must be correctly registered, currently licensed with a valid MOT Certificate, and be in roadworthy condition. Trade plates are forbidden. Cars may be scrutineered for compliance with the RTA prior to the event.

1.3 The event will run on Sunday, September 17th, 2023.

1.4 Entrants need not possess an MSUK Competition Licence. Drivers must posses a current and full driving licence, and have valid insurance in accordance with the requirements of the Road Traffic Act.

2.0 THE ROUTE

2.1 The total route is approximately 150 miles, starting and finishing at the CROOKLANDS HOTEL, near Kendal. 97/534837.

2.2 There will be no timing, but Entrants will be expected to reach the Finish by 6.00pm.

2.3 Entrants will be given detailed route instructions at the start of the event. The onus on finding the correct route rests with the Entrant. The route will be defined by abbreviated instructions explained in the route notes, tulip diagrams, and a marked map will be available.
